

# St. Peter's Youth Mission Trip 2020

Lumberton, NC July 12-18, 2020

**Trip organizer:** TEAMeffort

**Location:** Lumberton, North Carolina (580 miles/9 hours from St. Peter's)

**Dates:** Sunday July 12 (leave 7am) – Saturday July 18 (return 8pm)

**Cost:** \$550 per person

## **Cost Breakdown:**

TOTAL Cost - \$550 per person

TEAMeffort Cost - \$359 per person

Additional Costs (\$5,500 total divided by 25 missionaries) \$191 per person

- Vans (2 - 12 passenger vans) - \$3,500
- Gas - \$500
- 4 Meals not included in trip - \$800
  - Lunch Thursday @ activity - \$10/person
  - Dinner Thursday - \$15/person
  - Lunch Friday – picnic at beach \$5/person
  - Dinner Friday - \$10/person
- Meals with traveling – \$200
  - Students pack brown bag lunch for way down, plus donated snacks/drinks
  - \$10 per person for lunch on way home, plus donated snacks/drinks
- Free time activities - \$400
  - Thursday – Fantasy Lake Waterpark - \$15/person + \$25 deposit
  - Friday - Beach (i.e. – Oak Island, Old Bald Head Island, North Myrtle, Holden, Ocean Isle Beach, etc.)
- Drinks/Snacks for car – donated from church/parents
- Miscellaneous costs – \$100

## **Frequently Asked Questions:**

1. Where are we staying?
  - a. We will stay at a "Baptist on Mission" facility in Lumberton. It is on a church property and was built specifically for missionaries to stay in while helping in the area. The facility has showers, a kitchen, and eating area. We will do chapel at the church on the property.
2. Do we need cots?
  - a. There are twin beds in the facility. We just need to bring bedding/pillows.
3. Is there air conditioning?
  - a. YES!!! (hallelujah)
4. Will there be TEAMeffort staff on-site?
  - a. Yes, we will have a camp director and 4 staff members with us throughout the trip. At least 1 person will also be at our mission site with us as well.
5. Will there be other groups there at the same time as us?
  - a. Potentially. Other groups can sign up and if they do, we will eat meals together and worship together. However, each group has their own mission site so St. Peter's will work together on the same site(s) all week.
